



Dog Park Rules and Regulations

All rules pertaining to Smith's Clove Park, also pertain to this Dog Park

1. You are entering an off-leash dog park; ***enter at your own risk***. Neither the MJPRC, the Village and Town of Monroe, their officers, employees, agents or volunteers will be responsible in any way for people or their pets while in the dog park. Violation of these rules and regulations may result in suspension or revocation of membership and/or Dog park privileges.
2. MJPRC reserves the right to change these rules at any time
3. Dog owners/guardians must accept full responsibility for themselves, their children/guests and their dog(s) while in the park.
4. Owners are legally responsible for any damage, injury, or illness your dog(s) may cause to itself, other dogs, other people or yourself.
5. Owners must carry a leash at all times. Please leash and unleash your dog inside the double-gated holding area. Never carry your dog into the Dog Park.
6. Never open more than one gate at a time. If an owner and his/her dog(s) are in the holding area, stand outside and wait for him/her to enter or exit.
7. Owners will be issued a Dog Park authorization card with which they must carry on them at all times. Dogs must be licensed, vaccinated, healthy having no contagious conditions or diseases and be parasite-free.
8. Dogs showing aggression towards people or other animals must be immediately removed from the park by the owners/guardians. If you feel that you or your dog is in danger, simply leave the park, report the situation, and come back another day.
9. Owners should not leave their dogs unattended or allow them to be out of their sight.
10. An adult must accompany minor children.
11. Parents should refrain from bringing toddlers or small children into the park, unless they are willing to keep the children out of harm's way, totally under control and accept full responsibility for their safety. ***Please remember this is a Dog Park and not a playground for children.*** If your children create problems for owners and their dogs, you may be asked by other patrons to leave the Dog Park for safety's sake.
12. Children should not run with the dogs or chase them while in the park.
13. Puppies under four months of age are prohibited, as they are not yet protected from diseases.
14. Owners must clean up after their dogs. Waste disposal bags and trashcans are provided free.
15. Owners must stop dogs from digging and immediately fill holes.
16. The number of dogs per person is limited to three (3).
17. Dogs in heat will not be allowed inside the park.
18. Un-neutered males over the age of six (6) months will not be allowed inside the park.
19. No wolves or wolf hybrids allowed.
20. Toys or food can be a source of confrontation between dogs. Please don't bring them if other dogs are present.
21. Smokers must not throw cigarette butts on the grounds.
22. Do not bring glass containers into the Park.
23. Separate areas for large (over 30lbs) and small dogs are designated, please adhere to those guidelines.
